<p>5. <b>Christie Hall Report:</b> Lisa Chambers reported that the Kitchen installation and the perimeter fencing were nearing completion. Recently, a car accident damaged the metal railings and bench outside the Hall. The bench was being renewed and work on the railings was anticipated to commence shortly. Due to cost of hourly rental, many organisations find that the Community Hall is more economical for smaller meetings which was impacting revenue receipts. However, three new regular weekly bookings arrangements have been established at the Christie Hall. As a result of vandalism caused during a recent event at the Christie Hall, revised terms and conditions for hire are being considered.</p>
